Subject: Summary of Actions Taken at Oct. 6, 2008 Regular Town Commission Meeting

Mayor and Town Commissioners:

The following list is actions taken by the Commission at the meeting/s:

- 1. Approved the minutes of Sept. 15, 2008 (no revisions) and Sept. 24, 2008 with one revision stating that Comm Bingham suggested covering the remaining \$500 deductible for employee health coverage**
- 2. Approved Land Development Permit for seagrape removal with mitigation for the Miller residence, 6133 N Ocean Blvd. contingent on FDEP approval**
- 3. Accepted P & Z recommendation not to change existing Parking or Dune Vegetation ordinances**
- 4. Advised that price to construct slab/wall for generator at Turtle Beach reduced from \$15,692 to \$13,690 and the landscaping will be approximately \$700**
- 5. Directed staff to check into Palm Trees still in the ROW on Old Ocean Blvd. north of Corrine St. and advise owner of license to obstruct request**
- 6. Requested extra patrol and possible "Park and Walk" in area immediately north of Woolbright bridge where several burglaries have taken place**
- 7. Approved \$105,304 for paving of Inlet Cay Island and River Dr. from encumbered monies and to investigate other streets that may be paved with the remaining \$44,000 and provide at next meeting**
- 8. Staff to investigate possibility of utilizing trailer wood boardwalk at the Woolbright detention area**
- 9. Authorized staff to proceed with planning the Light the Lights and Open House function for Dec. 5, 2008 between 5:30 – 8:30 PM**
- 10. Directed staff to contact FDOT regarding flooding on Ocean Ave.**
