Mayor and Town Commissioners:

The following list is actions taken at the May 3, 2010 meeting/s:

- 1. Approved April 5, 2010 minutes**
- 2. Proclaimed May 25, 2010 as "National Missing Children's Day"**
- 3. Proclaimed May 9-15, 2010 as "National Police Week" and May 15, 2010 as Peace Officers Memorial Day and Encourage all Residents to Fly Flags as Half-Mast**
- 4. Proclaimed May as "Sand Sifters Appreciation Month" and presented same to Gary Solomon and other representatives**
- 5. Dr. Weege announced the creation of the Ocean Ridge Koi Garden Fund for necessary repairs to the Town Hall Koi Pond**
- 6. Authorized Town Manager to negotiate contract with Fleming Pest Management in an amount not to exceed \$21,000 for No Seeum control through Sept. 2010 with re-evaluation in July**
- 7. Approved the Annual Audit for FY 2008/09 by Nowlen, Holt and Miner, PA**
- 8. Authorized advertising for maintenance position that will be vacant in June 2010**
- 9. Directed staff to obtain total costs for new Town Entrance Signs including the base, color and/or material rendering, sufficient lighting, etc. to be presented at the June meeting (to be funded from the Beautification Reserve Account) (also to possibly include verbiage on bird sanctuary)**
- 10. Staff to research banning gigging, spearing or fishing for sharks or baiting fish on the public beaches**
- 11. Approved Ordinance 589; Amending Chapter 54, Article III, Section 54-87 Modifying the Provision for Overnight Parking on Public Streets or Vacant by prohibiting parking vacant lots at any time**
- 12. Revised the Facility Use Agreement to prohibit political events**
- 13. Directed staff to bring back proposed Ordinance 588 amending it by removing (c) in Section 2 at the June 7, 2010 meeting to designate the Town as a Bird Sanctuary**
