**Town Commission Meeting Summary**  
**March 6, 2017**

The following is a list of actions taken at the March 6, 2017 Regular Town Commission Meeting:

1. Approved the Regular Town Commission Meeting Minutes of February 6, 2017.
2. Approved the Special Town Commission Meeting Minutes of February 6, 2017.
3. Approved Poll Workers for the March 14, 2017 Municipal Election: Virginia McGinty, Clerk; Josef Cohan, Deputy; Joyce Bruck, Inspector; Doris Robin, Inspector, and Norman Schwartz, Inspector.
4. Announced that the Town will be providing free shredding services to residents on Saturday, April 22, 2017 from 9 a.m. until Noon at Town Hall.
5. Announced that the League of Women Voters and the Town of Ocean Ridge are sponsoring a Town Commissioner Candidates Forum on Thursday, March 9, 2017 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Town Hall. Residents of Ocean Ridge are welcome to attend and are encouraged to bring a question to submit to the Moderator / La Liga de mujeres votantes y la ciudad de Ocean Ridge están patrocinando un foro de candidatos ciudad Comisionado el jueves, 09 de marzo de 2017 de 18:00 a 20:00 en el Ayuntamiento. 6. Adopted a Proclamation Announcing that a Municipal Election will be held on March 14, 2017. There are two Town Commission Seats Open for a Three Year Term. Candidates are: Richard Bajakian, James A. Bonfiglio, Donald Magruder, and Nan Yablong / Proclama anunciando que una elección Municipal se celebrará el 14 de marzo de 2017. 7. Adopted a Proclamation Expressing Support for the Designation of March as "National Multiple Myeloma Awareness Month".
8. Announced that the Town Commission will consider appointments to the following Board positions at the April 3, 2017 Town Commission meeting: Board of Adjustment, 3 regular members for a three year term and 2 alternates for a one year term; Planning & Zoning Commission, 3 regular members for a three year term and 2 alternates for a one year term. Interested residents must be registered to vote in Ocean Ridge and submit a resume and letter of interest to the Town Clerk by March 27, 2017.
9. Authorized the Purchase of Two Fully Equipped Police Vehicles in an Amount Not to Exceed \$82,500.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2017-03; A Resolution of the Town Commission of the Town of Ocean Ridge, Florida, Approving and Authorizing Execution of an NPDES Fourth Cycle Permit Interlocal Agreement with Northern Palm Beach County Improvement District, the Lead Permittee.
11. Approved on second reading Ordinance No. 617: An Ordinance of the Town of Ocean Ridge, Florida, Amending Its Code of Ordinances By Amending Chapter 2, "Administration", Article II, "Officers and Employees", Division 3, "Town Clerk" to Clarify the Requirements of the Town Clerk; Providing for Codification, Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances, Severability, and an Effective Date.

12. Approved on second reading Ordinance No. 618: An Ordinance of the Town of Ocean Ridge, Florida, Amending Its Code of Ordinances by Amending Chapter 2 "Administration", Article VI "Finance", By Deleting Division 1 "Generally" and By Creating a New Division 1 "Purchasing Code" to Provide for Regulations Governing the Purchasing of Goods and Services; Providing for Codification, Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances, Severability, and an Effective Date.
