Ocean Ridge Closely Monitoring Hurricane Matthew

The Town of Ocean Ridge Administration and Police Department are closely monitoring Hurricane Matthew's forecast reports released from the National Hurricane Center for potential impacts on South Florida and Palm Beach County. We are preparing for potential heavy rainfall and wind associated with the tropical disturbance.

With the potential for several inches of rain, heavy coastal winds, and beach erosion; we urge all residents to [prepare](http://pbcgov.com/knowurzone/) (<http://pbcgov.com/knowurzone/>) for the storm today and closely monitor the progress of this disturbance via local media outlets and the official forecast update from the National Hurricane Center (<http://www.nhc.noaa.gov/>).

Town Hall will be closed on Thursday, October 6 and potentially Friday, October 7. No building inspections will be scheduled for either of those days.
