

**Tax-related Identity Fraud:**

It is tax season and although the deadline for filing has been extended, the criminal element is working overtime to submit an early return – in your name – to beat you to your refund. All the more reason to file early and to take precautions to maintain control of your personal information.

Remember; never give out any information in response to an unsolicited phone call or email. Furthermore, IRS employees will not telephone you to ask for your social security number, date of birth, mother’s maiden name, bank or credit card account details, etc. Hang up on these callers. The longer you stay on the phone, the greater the possibility that you may inadvertently give away a piece of your most precious asset; your identity.

**Unlawful Soliciting continues:**

Several incidents of door-to-door soliciting occurred during the month of January. Although we were not able to make any arrests, we certainly thank those who called the Police Department to report this activity as it allowed us to meet these folks and provide direction (education of the Town’s Ordinance and the way out of Town).

As previously mentioned, these unsolicited “salesmen” of magazines, requests for “charitable” contributions, offers to trim trees, etc. violate Town Code. In addition, these subjects do not have businesses licenses or insurance and some have been found to have a criminal history and/or warrants. Previously, we have had incidents of “Distraction Thefts”, where one person engages the homeowner in conversation while an accomplice sneaks into the home and steals jewelry and other valuables.

**“Enabling” these individuals via acts of kindness (giving them cash, water, food, etc.) is not beneficial. Your response should be swift and certain: “Not interested and leave!” Then call the Police at 561-732-8331. Your continued support is greatly appreciated. Keep those phone calls coming!**

**“Move Over!” It’s the law! :**

**Ocean Ridge is a community of two lane roadways. As such, drivers do not have the option to “move over” when passing a stopped emergency vehicle with emergency lights activated. Therefore, per Florida law, you MUST slow down to 20 miles per hour less than the posted Speed Limit.**

**On roadways with more lanes, drivers ARE REQUIRED to safely “move over” out of the lane closest to the emergency vehicle.**

**Statute 316.126(1)(b) specifically states that drivers:**

- 1. "Shall vacate the lane closest to the emergency vehicle or wrecker when driving on an interstate highway or other highway with two or more lanes traveling in the direction of the emergency vehicle or wrecker, except when otherwise directed by a law enforcement officer. If such movement cannot be safely accomplished, the driver shall reduce speed as provided in subparagraph 2."**
- 2. "Shall slow to a speed that is 20 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit when the posted speed limit is 25 miles per hour or greater; or travel at 5 miles per hour when the posted speed limit is 20 miles per hour or less, when driving on a two-lane road, except when otherwise directed by a law enforcement officer."**

**Annually, more Police Officers are killed or injured in traffic related incidents than any other activity. Please do what you can to reduce these statistics by following the law. Help protect the officers who are here to protect you!**
