PUBLIC NOTICE TO WATER SYSTEM CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH UTILITY

The City of Boynton Beach Water Utility will be temporarily changing its method of potable water treatment to free chlorination beginning Friday, June 9, 2017 through Friday, July 7, 2017. This is an annual process in which we switch to a stronger disinfection method in order to ensure that the potable water delivered to the customer is of the highest quality. As a result, the customer may notice a slight change in odor and taste in their water; otherwise there will be no adverse effects. Because of this change the following people should be aware of possible issues with their systems: users of home dialysis machines, owners of tropical fish aquariums and managers of stores and restaurants with holding tanks for fish and shellfish. These groups are encouraged to speak to an appropriate professional for guidance on how to operate their equipment during this period. Any changes will be eliminated when the Utility reverts to our normal disinfection method at the end of this period. Please be assured that this is a routine procedure and that there are no problems with your water supply.
