

ORDINANCE NO. 589

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 54, ARTICLE III, SECTION 54-87 MODIFYING THE PROVISIONS FOR OVERNIGHT PARKING ON PUBLIC STREETS OR VACANT LOTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 54-87 of the Town's Code of Ordinances prohibits the parking of any motor vehicle on any public street or on any vacant or unimproved land within the Town for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, Section 64-46(9)b prohibits all parking on any vacant parcel of land within the Town at any time; and

WHEREAS, there exists an inconsistency between the terms of Sections 54-87 and 64-46(9)b as they each pertain to parking on vacant land, which inconsistency can cause confusion in the enforcement of the Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings of Fact. The WHEREAS clauses set forth above are adopted herein as findings of fact.

Section 2. Amendment. The Code of Ordinances of the Town of Ocean Ridge, Florida, is hereby amended by amending Chapter 54, Article III, Section 54-87 which section shall read in its entirety as follows:

Sec. 54-87. Overnight parking on public streets prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle on any public street within the Town for a period of time longer than 30 minutes, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. of any day.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any section, paragraph, sub-paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 4. Repeal of Ordinances. Any ordinance in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




