

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-12**

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WHEREBY AGENCIES MAY REQUEST OR RENDER LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE TO THE OTHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCEMENT OF LAWS DIRECTLY RELATED TO SEXUAL PREDATOR AND OFFENDERS.

WHEREAS, the various Law Enforcement Agencies within Palm Beach County are interested in receiving and extending mutual aid assistance in the form of law enforcement services and resources to adequately respond to continuing multi-jurisdictional law enforcement problems; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Statute Section 23.1225(1)(a) specifically contemplates voluntary cooperation written agreements between subscribing Law Enforcement Agencies establishing joint city-county traffic enforcement task force agreements; and

WHEREAS, the subscribing Law Enforcement Agencies have been operating under a Memorandum of Understanding for Sexual Predator/Offender Tracking ("SPOT") in an effort to coordinate law enforcement relating to sexual predators and offenders and have identified a need for multi-jurisdictional authority in order to more effectively do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. the Town hereby authorizes the execution of the Mutual Aid Agreement - Sexual Predator/Offender Tracking Task Force in Palm Beach County (attached as Exhibit #1).

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
