

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-12

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER AND TOWN CLERK TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH (CITY) AND THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE (TOWN) FOR OVERFLOW BEACH PARKING AT OCEAN RIDGE TOWN HALL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, known as the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969" authorizes local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities that will harmonize geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, in June, 2000 the City of Boynton Beach and the Town of Ocean Ridge executed a Dispute Resolution Agreement whereby two parcels of property owned by the City and adjacent to the Town's administrative offices were conveyed to the Town pursuant to a Contract for Sale and Purchase; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the Town was to grant the City a right to access a portion of the parking spaces within the Town Hall parking lot for use as overflow parking when the parking lot at Oceanfront Park is full which became difficult for the Town when their new Town Hall was constructed; and

WHEREAS, this Interlocal Agreement will efficiently provide access to the area designated for overflow parking and establishes additional operational procedures for the overflow parking area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. the Town hereby authorizes the Town Manager and Town Clerk to execute the Interlocal Agreement (attached as Exhibit "A") between the City and the Town for the purpose of the providing overflow beach parking at the Ocean Ridge Town Hall.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner _____ who moved its adoption. Commissioner _____ seconded the motion.

The Mayor thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 7th day of December, 2009.
