

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-17

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2006-13 RELATED TO ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR OVERTIME PAY TO EMPLOYEES DURING THE FIRST SEVENTY-TWO HOURS OF A DECLARED EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2006, the Town Commission of the Town of Ocean Ridge adopted Resolution No. 2006-13 regarding establishing a policy for overtime pay to employees during the first 72 hours after a declared emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission wishes to amend the resolution to provide that the 72 hour period will not start until the employees are called in to begin the period of hurricane duty where they are not allowed to leave their post at town hall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN RIDGE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Town Commission had previously adopted Resolution No. 2006-13 on September 11, 2006 that established a policy setting forth the overtime pay to employees during the first 72 hours after a declared emergency.


Section 3. The Town Commission wishes to amend that policy to provide that the 72 hour period shall not commence upon the declaration of a state of emergency by the Federal or State government but upon the request by the Town Manager and/or Police Chief that certain employees need to report to Town Hall for the duration of the storm event where they will not be allowed to leave their job duties at town hall.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Bonfiglio who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner MaGruder.


The Mayor thereupon declared this Resolution approved and adopted by the Town Commission of the Town of Ocean Ridge, Florida, this 26th day of September, 2017.
